PERSONAL WAR SKETCH
OF

Comrade Leonard Johnson

Who was born the 30th day of November A.D. 18 22 in

County of Herkimier State of New York

I entered the service April 1, 1861 as Capt. of Co. "I" 6th Regt Wis Inf. and was discharged about Jan 1, 1862 on account of disability, and did not reenlist. Was discharged at Washington D.C.

I also enlisted Spet 26, 1844 and was a member of Co. "I" 5th U S. Inf. Enlisted in Bleecker St. N.Y.

Was in Battles of Cevro Gosdo, Monteray, Saltillo, Vera Cruz, Coronado, Buena Vista, and Resaca De La Pasina. Was shot though the right leg. Right shoulder, lop of my head, and the left foot, and was discharged from the Regular Army February 16, 1848.
