PERSONAL WAR SKETCH  
OF

Comrade Jesse Detrick

Who was born the Oct. 8 day of A.D. 18 33 in  
Milan County of Huron State of Ohio

I first entered the service Jan. 1, 1864 at Marshalltown Iowa, as a private in Co. "H." 13<sup>th</sup> Iowa Infantry and I was discharged at Louisville SC July 1<sup>st</sup> 1865, and finally discharged at Davenport Iowa, July 31, 1865. Close of the war, I was first in a battle at Padukia Kentucky, and in other engagements at Big Shanty, Nichajack Creek, Kennesaw Mountain, Atlanta, Jonesborough, Kingston, and with Sherman to the sea. Was in hospital at Davenport, Iowa, in Jan. 1865.

Intimate comrades were Thatcher Canfield, George Bartour, Jefferson Holcomb, Mortimer H. Brooks, Ed Thorn, Frank Guard.  
Was in the grand review at Washington D.C.
