PERSONAL WAR SKETCH  
OF

Comrade Elias B. Milles

Who was born the 19th day of November A.D. 1841 in

York County of York State of Penn.

I enlisted as a private in Co. "K" 130<sup>th</sup> Penn'a Vol. Inf. and was discharged with the rank of Corporal May 21, 1863 at expiration of enlistment. Re-enlisted Feb. 27 (20), 1865 as Corporal 192<sup>nd</sup> Penn'a Co "K" and was discharged August 24, 1865, close of war. My first battle was Antietam, Maryland, and others were Fredericksburg, and Chancellorsville.

I received a slight wound in the right hand at Antietam and was in Regimental Hospital.

Intimate comrades were George K. Bralton, John R. Feltrow. The battles mentioned above I think were among the fiercest of the war.

Fredericksburg Dec 12 & 13, 1862

Battle of Chancellorsville May 1863

Taken prisoner at Battle of Fredericksburg Dec 13, 1862-by D.H. Hills-Command.
