County of Cayuga State of New York

I enlisted Nov. 19, 1861 at Aurora Ill's, and was a member of Co. "H" 52d Ill Infantry, as a private, and was discharged on November 18th at Camp near Jackson Ga at expiration of term of service.

My first battle was Shiloh, and I was also at the siege of Atlanta. I was never wounded. Was in hospital at Keokuk, Iowa.

Intimate comrades were Wm N. Billings, Cornelius Snyder, Elijah Perrvigo, John Canterberger.
