I entered the United States service June 10, 1863 as a private at Davenport Iowa, in Company "H" 7<sup>th</sup> Iowa Cavalry and was discharged as a private on May 17, 1866 at Fort Leavenworth, Kansas the war having closed and having been in frontier service.

My first fighting was at Ceso Creek, Kansas and was in other engagements at Clyde and Ft. Elsworth Kansas in 1865.

Some of my most intimate comrades in the service were Charles Pepper, Nathan Monroe, James Powell-Hollock, and Weatherwax.
