Who was born the _____ day of _____ A.D. 18__36 in

Daylestown County of Buck State of Pennsylvania

I entered service at Daylestown Sept 15th 1862, as a private Company A 104 Redgt-Pennsylvania Volunteers. I held no office while I served. Was discharged at Norfolk, Virginia by order of the War department and re-enlisted.

My first battle was at James Island, South Carolina on July 16th 1863. I participated in engagements at Fort Wagner, Fort Gregg, Moris [sic] Island, S.C. and Foster's expedition of See Brook and Johns Island off South Carolina from 1st to 10th of July 1864.

Was never either wounded, confined in a hospital or taken prisoner.

A few of my most intimate comrades in service were: H.G. Shaddinger, Wm Shaddinger, Ed McIntosh, John Sievegly, Charles Combell, Charles Williams.
