Who was born the thirteenth day of November A.D. 1836 in
Copenhagen County of Lewis State of New York

I first entered service Aug. 9, 1862 at Clinton Iowa. I entered as private of C. 26 Reg. Iowa
Infantry Vol. I held the offices of Colorbearer, Lieut. & Captain. Promoted to Colorbearer Sep
1862- to Lieut Jan. 1863 & to Captain May 1865 which office I held until I was discharged at
Washington June 6, 1865, which ended my three years of Service.

The first battle I was engaged was t Walnut-Hills and at Vicksburg and Ark Post.
I was wounded at Ark Post Jan 11- 1863-
Some of my most intimate comrades were Adjut D. G. Butterfield, Cap. G. G. Crozer, Lieu. Thomas G
Farsely, Lieu. E.L. Biny. Cap. Johnson.

The most important event of my service was as quartermaster, looking after the best interest of the
soldiers and getting the best things going. I was a good forager and provided a way to carry the boys
knapsacks.
