PERSONAL WAR SKETCH  
OF

Comrade Rudold Brecher

Who was born the 25th day of August A.D. 1843 in  
Nassau County of Germany State of \_\_\_\_\_

Enlisted 11<sup>th</sup> day of September 1861 in Company B. 36<sup>th</sup> Illinois Infantry Aurora Volunteers. Served in the army of the Cumberland. RE-enlisted December 1863. Granted a 30 days furlough. January 1864 to go home to Aurora Illinois. Had rank of sergeant. Served in Atlanta campaign in summer of 1864 taking part in twent battles including Pea Ridge, Stone River, Kenesaw [sic] Mountain, Missionary Ridge. Served under General Thomas and General Phil Sheridan. Was wounded in the head at Battle of Chicamaugua.

Served 4 years and 2 months

Mustered out at New Orleans and sent to Springfield Illinois

Honorably discharged October 14 1865.
