PERSONAL WAR SKETCH
OF

Comrade Orville James

Who was born the nineteenth day of September A.D. 1845 in
County of Wyandor State of Ohio

I entered the service at Bucyrus, Crawford Co. Ohio September 28, 1863, as a private, and was assigned to "A," Co. Twelfth Ohio Vol Cavalry, as wagones and served as wagones until the close of the war and was discharged at Nashville Tenn. On the 14th day of November 1865. I was in two engagements during my term of service, in both instances, with Guerillas in Kentucky. I was never wounded or captured, and was not confined in a hospital during my term of service. My most intimate comrades were Jacob Dunlap, James Pugh, and Delancey Longwell, of my company.

Died September 18, 1929
